NOTES:

(1) **DUTY ROSTERS.** Shelley Sailing Club is run entirely by volunteers. Members 14 years and over will be placed on the duty rosters to assist the Officer of the Day in the opening, closing, and cleaning of the clubhouse, as well as with race starts/finishes and in the canteen. Families would normally be expected to contribute at least two members to the duty rosters.

(2) **MEMBERSHIP.** Family, Senior, and Junior memberships include \$30 canteen vouchers (non refundable). This amount can be added to at any time but note that no credit will be given by the canteen.

A family membership includes all members of a family residing at the same address. To be eligible for junior membership an individual must have been under 19 years of age or a full-time student under 21 years of age at 30th June 2009.

New members joining after 1st January 2010 should pay half of the listed membership fee.

(3) **YACHTING AUSTRALIA FEES** are now incorporated into SSC membership fees. All Junior, Senior, Life, and Family members will be entered in the YA database unless they are indicated on the membership form as non-sailors. A non-sailor is someone who sails in less than three races in a calendar year.

(4) **TRAINING.** For insurance purposes, trainees must be members of SSC and must therefore pay the applicable membership fee as well as the training fee.

(5) **THE RON TOUGH YACHTING FOUNDATION** provides funds to improve the standard of sailing in WA. Over the years the fund has been used to provide rescue and training equipment, coaching and other assistance to many WA clubs and crews, including Shelley Sailing Club. Members are urged to make a donation to this worthy cause. Donations of \$2 or over are now tax deductible.

(6) **DONATIONS TO SSC** may be used in several ways:

MARTIN FLUX FUND. Martin Flux was a young enthusiastic member and Rear Commodore of the Shelley Sailing Club whose cheerful assistance and encouragement to junior sailors has been sadly missed since the tragic accident that took his life in 1988. Martin's family have since made several generous donations to the Shelley Sailing Club leading to the establishment of the Martin Flux Fund to support junior sailing and to remind members of the valuable contribution made by this popular young man. Over the past few years the fund has been used initially to purchase the new fibreglass Mudlark "Marty", several secondhand Mudlarks for loan/resale to members and an inflatable dinghy to assist in the coaching of the junior fleet.

Members are urged to support this important Club fund to whatever extent they are able.
